



Premier Dog Exhibitor Award

INTRODUCTION

Thanks to an inspired bill passed during the 2020 4-H Legislature event, South Dakota 4-H is launching the Premier Dog Exhibitor Award beginning with the 2022 season. This award recognizes a more comprehensive development of dog project knowledge. The premise of the award mirrors the three points of the 4-H Livestock Management Triangle.

AWARD CATEGORIES

There will be one award for each of the three 4-H age divisions (beginner, junior, senior). The awards are presented at a ceremony at the State Dog Show in Huron, SD when all events are concluded.

SCORING MATRIX

The scores for the Premier Dog Exhibitor Award will be determined by the qualifying events at the State Dog Show in Huron. Each event contributes one third of the overall score. Maximum score is 300 points.

SCORING and PARTICIPATION DETAILS

- If a youth shows multiple animals in the same category, the highest score prevails. Youth cannot gain more than 100 points per matrix column.
- **Tie-breakers:** showmanship → skill-a-thon contest → event → coin toss
