Remember, 4HOnline enrollment for the 2021-2022 4-H year is open at <https://v2.4honline.com> or by going to the SDSU Extension Website: <https://extension.sdstate.edu>; click on the 4-H tab scroll down until you see the Enroll Now button. 4-H leaders and 4-H registered volunteers will need to re-enroll at this time also.

For those who want to 4-H Rodeo this summer, you must be enrolled in 4-H by May 1, 2022.

All youth enrollment and project area selection is due by May 31st to be eligible to exhibit/participate at state level events.

4-H Insurance Due April 19th

Notice Date Change From April 18th

All 4-H members are required to have 4-H insurance. American Income Life Insurance Company (AIL) provides the following insurance policies for South Dakota. Below is the cost: Rodeo participants, who have already sent in your Insurance Declaration Form 1and didn't pay either the \$2.50 or \$40 rodeo insurance, please do ASAP.

- ◆ If the 4-H member is in non-horse projects the cost is \$1.50.
- ◆ Cloverbud insurance is \$1.50.
- ◆ If the 4-H member is in horse project the cost is \$2.50.
- ◆ If the 4-Her is in rodeo, insurance cost is \$40 unless the family has its own insurance to cover rodeo, then they must purchase the \$2.50 horse insurance.

The 2022 rodeo forms are due by **May 1, 2022** to be eligible to 4-H rodeo. Rodeo forms (page 4-5-6) need to be sent to the State 4-H Rodeo Secretary Kim Larson.

The insurance declaration form needs to be turned into the 4-H Office with insurance payment of \$2.50 or \$40.

SD 4-H Animal Identification

I have attached the 4-H animal identification guidelines (this was emailed to animal families 2/9/2022), it's a help sheet for you to use as you're picking your livestock for 4-H achievement days. Beef, Dairy Cattle, Dairy Goats, Meat Goats, Sheep, Swine, Poultry and Rabbits must have some form of identification. The attached help sheet should help you determine what form of identification you will be needing. The 4-H Office

has the 4-H NUES Tags available, just let the 4-H Office know how many you need. I also have poultry leg bands on hand in the 4-H Office.

Entering Animals in 4HOnline June 1 Deadline

4-H families were able to start entering animals into 4HOnline on **Friday, March 11, 2022** and will close for families to enter the animals on **Wednesday, June 1st at 11:59 pm CST**.

Poultry Update

The Department of Game Fish & Parks has reported that South Dakota has had its first case of Avian Bird Flu for the 2022 season. What does this mean in relation to live poultry shows during the upcoming fair season? Right now, there are no regulations for South Dakota, but we will continue to watch for updates from the Animal Industry Board (AIB). Poultry Pullorum Free Proof

Poultry purchased from your local farm store or hatchery must come from a certified Pullorum-Typhoid free source, or have been tested to prove that they are Pullorum-Typhoid free. Make sure you request a certificate proving that they are disease free and keep for your records. If you do not have the paperwork that your poultry is disease free, they will need to be tested by a certified tester.
