4-H Insurance Due April 1st ALL 4-H members are REQUIRED to

have 4-H insurance. American Income Life Insurance Company (AIL) provides the following insurance policies for South Dakota. Below is the cost:

- If the 4-H member is in non-horse projects the cost is \$1.50.
- Cloverbud insurance is \$1.50.
- If the 4-H member is in horse project the cost is \$2.50.
- If the 4-Her is in rodeo, insurance cost is \$40 unless the family has its own insurance to cover rodeo, then they must purchase the \$2.50 horse insurance.

If paying with a check, please make check payable to Prairie Winds 4-H.

Deadline is Tuesday, April 1, 2025.

Be sure to enroll or re-enroll in 4-H at <u>https://v2.4honline.com</u> and if you are not a member of a 4-H club, **you need to enroll as a Hughes/Stanley Member at Large, not Blunt 4-H Rodeo or Central SD 4-H Rodeo.**

Then fill out all forms and mail to the State 4-H Finals Secretary **by May 1, 2025**. The 2025 4-H Rodeo Contestant Packet will be attached.

New this Year—There will be a new \$20 administrative fee per contestant. This was voted on at the annual meeting in October 2023.

DNA Samples

All market animals (market beef, market goat, market sheep, and market swine) intended for 4-H competition at the SD State Fair are required to submit DNA samples. A DNA sample must be self-identified and submitted to the 4-H Office by **May 19, 2025** for State Fair eligibility. Market animals without a DNA sample on file will be ineligible for competition at the SD State Fair, regardless of the participating status in the County 4-H Achievement Days/County Fair. DNA sampling is the responsibility of the 4-H member. DNA envelopes are available at the 4-H Office.

4-H NUES Green Tags

Market animals that do not have a Federal or NUES tag must be tagged with a 4-H NUES Green Tag to be exhibited at the County Achievement Days/Fair and SD State Fair 4-H Show. **Please note:** that baby calves do not need a green tag since this is a **county lot only** and if you are only showing your animal at county level, you will not need to get a green tag, **ONLY ANIMALS GOING TO THE SD STATE FAIR.**

Livestock Lease Form

4-H members may lease livestock. All livestock lease forms must be turned into the 4-H Office before May 27, 2025, so they can be uploaded into 4HOnline. A 4-H Livestock Lease Form is attached.
