Prairie Winds 4-H livestock pre-registration forms for 4-H Achievement Days will be emailed to those individuals who completed the Youth Livestock Literacy certification requirement, the last week of June and due July 21st into the 4-H Office.

Fashion Revue

Fashion Revue is a 4-H Youth-in-Action event that promotes life skills such as clothing selection, fit, coordination, and construction. Each 4-Her constructs and/or selects his/her own garment in which to model in front of a panel of judges. Through participation in this event, 4-Hers have the opportunity to learn about wardrobe selection, accessorizing, poise, presence, and consumer purchasing/buying techniques.

The Fashion Revue Contest is scheduled for **Monday, July 21, 2025** at the SDSU Pierre Regional Center. **1:00 pm CT. Pre-registrations are due to the 4-H Office no later than Monday, July 14th.**

For all pre-registrations forms for the various Youth-in-Action events, please contact the 4-H Office for forms and I will email them out to you.

Breed Registration Papers

A copy of breed registration papers for registered or purebred animals **must be uploaded in Fair Entry by August 12, 2025**. Registration paper must reflect ownership as of June 1 if purchased. It is recommended that exhibitors have the original paper copy of the registration paper in hand during check in at both Achievement Days and State Fair.

For State Fair, registration papers must be in the member's name, farm name, family name or sibling name.

Poultry Pullorum Testing Requirement

Just a reminder, if you are planning on exhibiting poultry this year in 4-H, before purchasing your poultry, be aware of some of the rules regarding Pullorum-Typhoid Disease.

Poultry must come from a certified Pullorum-Typhoid free source or have a test done to prove that they are Pullorum-Typhoid free. If you purchase your chicks from a farm store or hatchery, request a certificate proving they are Pullorum-Typhoid free and keep your receipt.

If you do not have the paperwork proving that your birds are Pullorum-Typhoid free, you will need to have them tested by a certified tester. The veterinarian will need to see the certificate it issue a CVI for achievement days and/or state fair. If you need to have your birds tested, please contact the 4-H Office by **July 8, 2025**.

Skill-A-Thon Resources

Horticulture: There is a Horticulture Skill-A-Thon handbook and study guides available. The information in the handbook is related to an event overview, rules and regulations, and the different components of the event. The study guides are the documents that the information will be pulled for the exams.

Consumer Decision Making: The Consumer Decision Making Skill-A-Thon resources include PowerPoints, ID Booklets and Definitions under the three categories (Food and Cooking; Housing and Interior Design; Sewing and Clothing).

Scantron Sheets: Consumer Decision Making and Horticulture Skill-A-Thons utilize a scantron sheet for their answers at State Fair. In order to help youth feel more comfortable before competing in the events, a link has been provided to the practice scantron on the State Fair page on the SDSU Extension Website. Youth are encouraged to use the practice sheet prior to competing in the event.

The public presentation contest is scheduled for **Wednesday, June 25, 2025** at the SDSU Pierre Regional Center beginning at 9 am.

Registration deadline is **June 18, 2025**.

Dates/Deadlines/Reminders:

As June quickly approaches, please keep in mind the deadlines associated with livestock (horse) projects. Below are the deadlines for livestock (horse) project materials:

June 1:

- Animal ownership
- Animal identification in 4-H Online
- Animal lease form (if applicable)
- Youth Horse Literacy Certification completion
- Remember, feeder calves do not get entered into 4HOnline, this is a **COUNTY CLASS ONLY**

July 1:

- Youth Livestock Literacy completion

August 12:

- Registration papers uploaded to Fair Entry (if applicable)
 - ⇒ Registration paper must reflect ownership as of June 1
 - ⇒ If animal is leased, registration paper must be in the animal owner's name/farm name
