Kid Kare Virtual Babysitting Series

The 4-H Youth Program Advisors of Brookings, Codington, Day, Deuel, Grant, Roberts and Marshall Counties will be hosting a 6-week virtual babysitting preparation series, Kid Kare, starting March 27th.

Live Zoom Presentation Dates:

March 27th ~ April 3 ~ April 10 ~ April 17 ~ April 24 and May 1.

Virtual learning experience for ages 9 & up focused on fundamental childcare knowledge & skills. A babysitting kit filled with essentials and activity supplies for the workshop is included in the \$15 enrollment.

Kid Kare is a great opportunity whether you want to start your own baby-sitting business or just want to be able to help out with siblings at home. Participants receive a certificate of completion upon finishing the workshop.

Topics include Understanding Kids, Caring for Children, Safety First, Nutrition Activities with Kids, and Babysitting as a Business.

If you are not able to attend this training, you may attend YHL in another county or complete an online Traininghouse Horse Safety Training which will be launched by May 1, 2023.

This training needs to be completed by **June 1, 2023** to be eligible to complete in any county and/or state horse related event (this includes judging, hippology, etc.).

2023 State 4-H Scholarships

4-H Insurance Due April 17th

All 4-H members are required to have 4-H insurance. American Income Life Insurance Company (AIL) provides the following insurance policies for South Dakota. Below is the cost:

- If the 4-H member is in non-horse projects the cost is \$1.50.
- Cloverbud insurance is \$1.50.
- If the 4-H member is in horse project the cost is \$2.50.
- If the 4-Her is in rodeo, insurance cost is \$40 unless the family has its own insurance to cover rodeo, then they must purchase the \$2.50 horse insurance.

If paying with a check, please make check out to Prairie Winds 4-H.

Deadline is Monday, April 17, 2023.
