Youth AI Day Camp

Youth AI Day Camp will be held on Friday, March 18 in Colton, SD. YQCA (Youth for the Quality Care of Animals) Instructor—Led Training

Four-H youth ages 8 to 18 exhibiting beef cattle, dairy cattle, dairy goats, meat goats, sheep, swine, poultry, and rabbits at county-level fairs or State Fair will be **required** to become YQCA certified.

Certification for Stanley/Sully/Hughes County 4-H members will be held **Monday, April 18, 2022** beginning at 1 pm (CT) at the Pat Duffy Community Center, Fort Pierre, SD. Registration will be done online for this training. Families can begin registering by following the steps outlined in the help sheet attached to this newsletter. At step 14, you will need to search for the training titled Hughes/Stanley/Sully County 4-H YQCA Training; Pat Duffy community Center on April 18th. The cost for the instructor-led training will be \$3.00/youth.

If you are unable to make the instructor-led training you can do the web-based training, but the cost will be \$12/youth.

YQCA certification must be completed and certificate uploaded to 4HOnline by **July 1, 2022.**

Horse Safety Training

All safe skills and Youth Horse Trainings must be completed each year by 4-H members in order to participate in any county or state horse event. This includes horse judging and hippology.

Horse Safety Training is scheduled for **Wednesday, April 27th** beginning at 4:30 pm CT. The location of the training is yet to be determined. A second training will be announced at a later date.

2022 State 4-H Scholarships

4-H youth who have at least five years of active membership in South Dakota 4-H, **are current high school seniors, or are enrolled at SDSU are eligible to apply** for most South Dakota 4-H Scholarships. Applications need to be **postmarked by April 1st** of this year to be considered.

Most 4-H scholarship awards are based on fulfillment of scholarship-specific criteria and the following:

- 40% scholastic achievement;
- 10% character;
- 40% 4-H project involvement including Citizenship/Community Service and Leadership;
- 10% financial need

4-H Insurance Due April 18th

All 4-H members are required to have 4-H insurance. American Income Life Insurance Company (AIL) provides the following insurance policies for South Dakota. Below is the cost:

- ◆ If the 4-H member is in non-horse projects the cost is \$1.50.
- ◆ Cloverbud insurance is \$1.50.
- ◆ If the 4-H member is in horse project the cost is \$2.50.
- ◆ If the 4-Her is in rodeo, insurance cost is \$40 unless the family has its own insurance to cover rodeo, then they must purchase the \$2.50 horse insurance.

4-H Rodeo Forms Due May 1

The 2022 rodeo forms are due by **May 1, 2022** to be eligible to 4-H rodeo. Rodeo forms (page 4-5-6) need to be sent to the State 4-H Rodeo Secretary Kim Larson.

The insurance declaration form needs to be turned into the 4-H Office with insurance payment of \$2.50 or \$40.
