All rodeo forms have been updated. Be sure to enroll or re-enroll in 4-H at <https://v2.4honline.com/> and if you are not a member of a 4-H Club, you need to enroll as a Hughes/Stanley Member at Large, not Blunt 4-H Rodeo or Central SD 4-H Rodeo.

Then fill out all forms and mail to the State 4-H Finals Secretary by **May 1, 2025**.

Remember, there will be a new \$20 administrative fee per contestant. This was voted on at the annual meeting in October 2023. Please read the contestant packet thoroughly it has information about Rodeo Entry Check List, Incomplete Entries, How to Check Your Eligibility, Late Entry Process and Jr Jr Division.

DNA Samples

All market animals (market beef, market goat, market sheep, and market swine) intended for 4-H competition at the SD State Fair are required to submit DNA samples. A DNA sample must be self-identified and submitted to the 4-H Office by **May 19, 2025** for State Fair eligibility. Market animals without a DNA sample on file will be ineligible for competition at the SD State Fair, regardless of the participating status in the County 4-H Achievement Days/County Fair. DNA sampling is the responsibility of the 4-H member. DNA envelopes are available at the 4-H Office.

4-H NUES Green Tags

Market animals that do not have a Federal or NUES tag must be tagged with a 4-H NUES Green Tag to be exhibited at the County Achievement Days/Fair and SD State Fair 4-H Show. **Please note:** that baby calves do not need a green tag since this is a **county lot only** and if you are only showing your animal at county level, you will not need to get a green tag, **ONLY ANIMALS GOING TO THE SD STATE FAIR.**

The County 4-H Horse Show is quickly approaching. The show is scheduled for **Tuesday, June 24, 2025** at the Stanley County Fairgrounds, Fort Pierre, SD. Registration begins at 8:30 a.m. with the show beginning at 9 a.m. (all times are central). **Note: English Classes will be first followed immediately with the Western Classes.** All participants are required to enter in showmanship.

Also, be sure you have your horse(s) and all photos uploaded into 4HOnline if you haven't done so already. June 1st is the deadline.

Please complete and return the Horse Show Entry Blank to the 4-H Office no later than **Monday, June 16, 2025.** You can mail, drop off or scan and email the pre-registration form to the 4-H Office.

All 4-H members are required to exhibit at a county horse show as their qualifying event to be eligible to participate at the State 4-H Horse Show. The SD State 4-H Horse Show is **July 8-10, 2025** in Huron, SD in the DEX Building on the State Fair Fairgrounds. **Deadline to register for the State 4-H Horse Show is June 27, 2025 by 12 Noon.** URL to be used for State 4-H Horse Show is listed below:
