### New 4-H Year Began October 1st!

All 4-H members will need to re-enroll in 4-H to become active members. 4-H members must be 8 years old on or before January 1, 2019. Youth may not be 19 or older on or before January 1, 2019. Cloverbuds must be ages 5-7 as of January 1, 2019.

**New members** enrolling for the first time ever in 4-H may enroll online by going to 4HOnline at <https://sd.4honline.com> or by going to the iGrow website and click on the button **Enroll in 4-H!**

Please use Mozilla FireFox (preferred) or Google Chrome. **Do Not use Internet Explorer.**

4-H families that are currently members **Do NOT** set up a new profile, just go in and edit any changes and update where required. Also, be sure birthdates are correct.

If you **do not** have internet access, please contact the 4-H Office. I can either mail 4-H enrollment forms to you or you may set up a time to stop in the Extension Office and enroll or re-enroll. It is strongly encouraged to enroll as soon as possible so members don't miss out on 4-H club meetings, activities and project deadlines.

4-H leaders and 4-H registered volunteers will need to re-enroll also.

## Youth for the Quality Care of Animals

Youth for the Quality Care of Animals (YQCA) is a national multi-species quality assurance program for youth ages 8 to 21 with a focus on three core pillars: food safety, animal well-being, and character development. The YQCA program is an annual certification created for youth producing and/or showing beef cattle, dairy cattle, sheep, meat goats, dairy goats, pigs, poultry and rabbits.

The registration fee for instructor led (only 8 to 18 may attend) YQCA trainings is \$3 per person and the registration fee for the online training (open to all ages) is \$12 per person. Certification is good for all food-producing animals (beef cattle, dairy cattle, sheep, meat goats, dairy goats, swine, poultry and rabbits) a you exhibits in a year; youth must complete one certification each year.

YQCA certification needs to be completed and uploaded to 4HOnline by July 1, 2019. Youth exhibiting beef cattle, dairy cattle, dairy goats, meat goats, sheep, swine, poultry and rabbits at county-level fairs or State Fair will be required to become YQCA certified for the 2018-19 4-H year.
